Spring is Boston's favorite season! As the weather turns nice, this New England city bursts to life. For locals, spring in Boston really begins with the first pitch at Fenway Park. One by one, you'll see the shops on Newbury Street prop open their doors and set up their outdoor patios. A walk through Boston's Public Garden is a must when the flowers bloom just in time for the Flower Show (March 24-28, 2010). The season's signature event? The annual Boston Marathon takes place on Monday, April 19, 2010.

Spring is a great season to spend your time outside in Philadelphia; the temperatures are not too cold or too hot. Take a leisurely stroll or enjoy a picnic in one of the five open-spaced parks in Philadelphia: Franklin Square, Logan Square, Love Park, Rittenhouse Square and Washington Square. Bike along the Schuylkill River Trail, a 23-mile trail running from Center City Philadelphia to Valley Forge National Historical Park or take a drive to Longwood Gardens and view the beautiful flowers, trees and architecture at one of the world's premier horticultural showplaces.

Washingtonians herald the departure of winter when the world-famous cherry blossoms cast their characteristic pink petals over the Tidal Basin. The cherry blossoms, however, aren't the only reason to plan a spring getaway in the nation's capital. It's a season of festivals, parades, garden tours and more. At the end of March is the annual Smithsonian Kite Festival marking the start of the National Cherry Blossom Festival luring competitive kite flyers and amateurs alike to the grounds of the Washington Monument. Film lovers throughout the region descend upon the nation's capital for springtime film events, such as the Washington, DC International Film Festival and the DC Independent Film Festival. Spring also signals the beginning of the tour season as walking, biking, Segway and boating companies resume their tour schedules. Gardening lovers will enjoy the National Cathedral Flower Mart while arts and craft enthusiasts will enjoy the Smithsonian Craft Show.

MEMBERSHIP DUES RATE CHANGES

Due to rising costs, we are instituting a modest increase of \$50 annually for non-resident members effective April 1, 2010. New non-resident annual dues are \$500 plus tax (\$544.37 tax inclusive). If you are a renewing member paying monthly, the monthly charge will increase from \$40.83 to \$45.36 (tax inclusive). Pre-pay in full before April 1st to save - call 212.626.9373 or email info@terraceclub.com for more information. The new non-resident restriction will increase to living and working more than 90 miles from NYC; existing members will not be affected.
